PhD thesis prize 2023

Call for applications

The Doctoral School 352 PhD thesis prize aims to distinguish five of the best doctoral theses defended in **2023**.

The documents required to apply for the PhD thesis award are as follows:

- The candidate's CV including a list of publications, which have been published or submitted prior to the defense, including their DOI link.
- A copy of the referee reports and the defense committee's report,
- A link to the electronic version of the PhD thesis.
- A recommendation letter from an expert of the PhD thesis field, who was not member of the PhD committee.

Please note that to be eligible, the duration of the thesis must not exceed 40 months.

Applications must be deposited in a **single pdf document** before March 19, 2024, 12:00 CET using the link:

The recommendation letter can be either added to the pdf document or sent directly to the doctoral school (<u>ED352-direction@univ-amu.fr</u>)

The applicants will also send an e-mail to the doctoral school (<u>ED352-direction@univ-amu.fr</u>) mentioning that they uploaded their application files. Their application is accepted when they receive an acknowledgement of receipt from the doctoral school.

The candidates for the Doctoral School's PhD thesis prize will be proposed by the Doctoral School Board to the Doctoral School council in April 2024. The laureates will be notified, and their names will be published on the Doctoral School website. The awards ceremony will be held during the "Journée Scientifique de l'Ecole Doctorale" (JSED) in June 2024.
